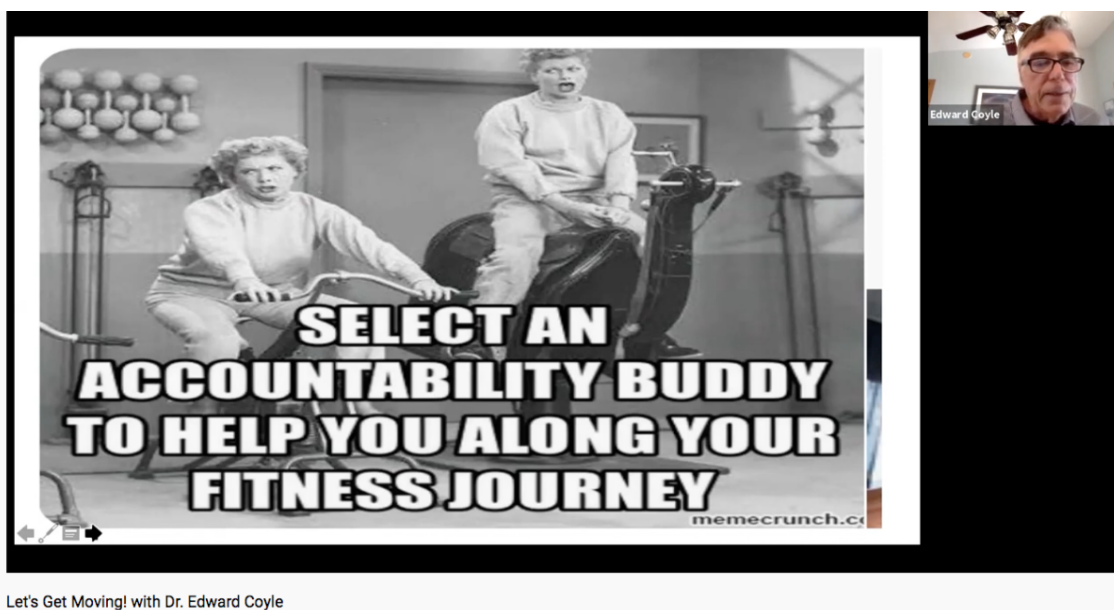
Village Writers Series Continues with Elizabeth Crook

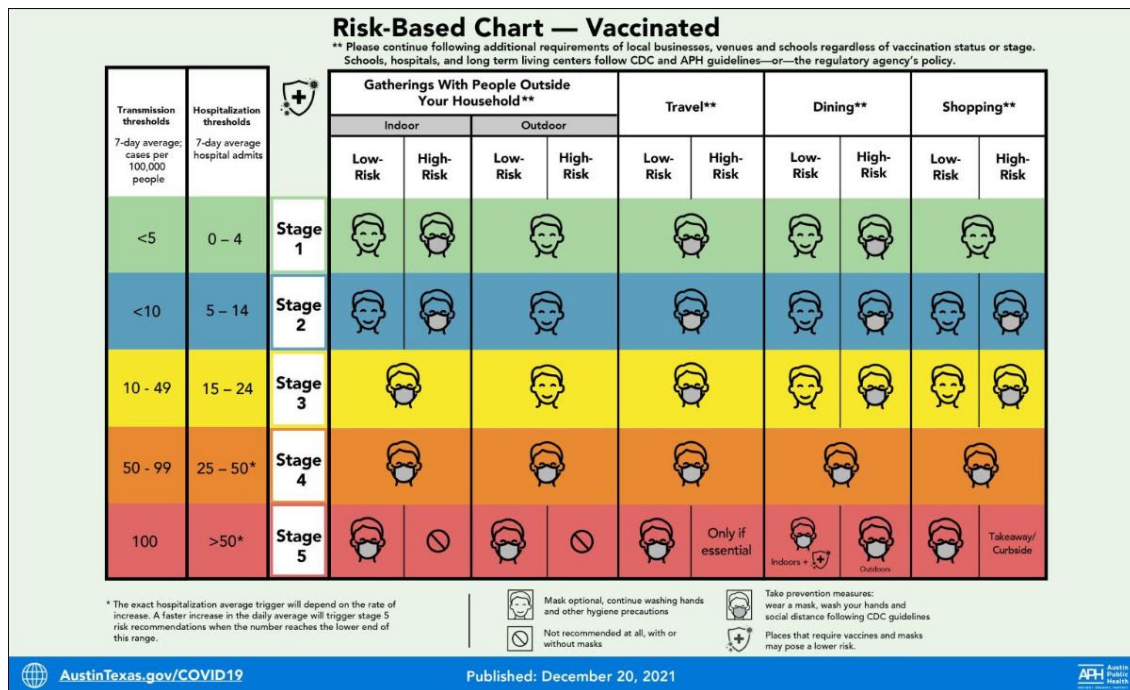

Austin Has Returned to Stage 4

Capital City Village continues to provide services to members. However, stage 4 requires that both members and volunteers wear properly-fitting masks regardless of vaccination status.

Dr. Desmar Walkes, Austin's Medical Director, did a program for CCV July 21, the last time we were headed into stage 4. When she was recently asked about the New Year's Eve fireworks, she said they will go as planned but that they expect people not to gather to watch the show.

“That is to be viewed from afar, there are no plans for gathering, there are no vendors, no bands,” Walkes said. “We are expecting people to view it from their vehicles or in the downtown area people may be able to look at it through their windows.”

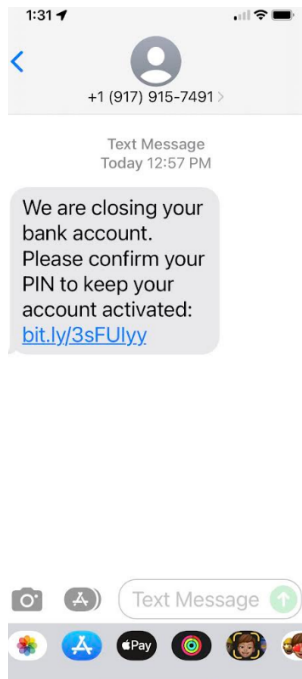
