### **KEEP IN MIND:**

- STRICT limit of 4 regular-sized boxes (no larger than 24" L x 20" W x 20" H) OR 5 grocery-sized bags (paper/ reusable bags) PER VEHICLE.
- Do not exit your vehicle. Event staff will take items from your vehicle and return your boxes or bags to you.
- No walk-ups accepted.
- · Personal materials only.
- Do not arrive before 10 am. Shredding will not begin earlier.
- It's not necessary to remove staples, rubber bands, tape, adhesive labels, paper clips, or plastic tabs.
- · Walt times are possible.

### **NOT ACCEPTED:**

- Hard plastics
- Plastic bags
- Electronic media
- Binders or materials in metal prong fasteners, brass fasteners, or binder clips
- Bound materials such as spiral notebooks or books
- Business records
